BID EVENTS

Breath of Life Cheer Challenge - University of Guelph, Guelph, ON (1-day, 1-run)

Sun. Nov. 30th, 2025

1 paid bid

8 at-large bids

All bids earned at Breath of Life must be used at the 2026 All Star World Championships.

Beast of the East Cheer Challenge - Queen's University, Kingston, ON (1-day, 1-run)

Sun. Feb. 22nd, 2026

3 at-large bids

At-large bids earned at Beast of the East can be deferred to 2027.

Cheer Challenge Cup - Blue Mountain Conference Centre, Blue Mountain, ON (2-day, 2-run event)

Sat/Sun. Mar.27th-29th, 2026

1 paid bid

8 at-large bids

At-large bids earned at Cheer Challenge Cup can be deferred to 2027.

The paid bid can only be deferred if the team has not already earned an at-large bid.

AT-LARGE BID WINNERS: Teams receiving at-large bids will receive \$50 off of athlete registration. At-large bids earned earlier in the season may be upgraded to a paid bid at Cheer Challenge Cup. Upgraded at-large bids will not be rolled down.

PAID BID WINNERS: Teams who have earned a paid bid will receive free registration to the Allstar World Championship and a 1-day park to park complimentary pass for all athletes and two coaches. If the team that earns the paid bid at Cheer Challenge Cup already has an at-large bid, they can not defer the paid bid and it must be used in 2026.

TEAM ELIGIBILITY

Any team competing for an ASW bid will need to meet the following eligibility requirements:

- The team must be entered in a bid eligible division (see below)
- Must have 50% of the programs Prep and All Star teams attend any Cheer Challenge Canada 2025-2026 event. This requirement can be met across multiple events.

Breath of Life: Nov. 30th

Extreme Chill: Jan. 25th

Quest of the Southwest: Feb. 1st

Beast of the East: Feb. 22nd

Cheer Challenge Cup: Mar. 27th-29th

DECLARATION

Prior to each event, all teams will be required to complete a bid declaration form. A separate google form must be completed for each team and event and this will be provided closer to competition.

SCORING

At Cheer Challenge Canada events, all teams will be scored using the [Cheer Canada scoring system](#). At The All Star World Championships, all teams will be scored using [The All Star Worlds scoring system](#).

Level 1: U8, U12, U16, U18

Level 2: U8, U12, U16, U18

Level 3: U12, U16, U18

Level 4: U12, U16, U18

Level 4.2: U18

Level 5: U12, U16, U18

Level 4NT/5NT/6NT: Int'l Open

Please note:

1. International divisions have been removed from the 2026 All Star World Championships.

U8/U12/U16/U18 teams will compete in the closest correlating division (Mini/Youth/Junior/Senior)

Cheer Challenge Canada recognizes that there are differences between the Cheer Canada Age Grid and the ASW Age Grid that may not best suit your team composition. Regrettably, we will not be able to offer age exceptions outside of the Cheer Canada age grid at Cheer Challenge Canada events.

BID DISTRIBUTION

Events with 1 paid, 8 at-large bids

- a. Paid Bid - Highest overall score at the event
- b. At Large #1, 2 - Highest scores in the combined U16/U18/IO eligible divisions
- c. At Large #3, 4 - Highest scores in the combined U8/U12 eligible divisions
- d. At Large #5, 6, 7, 8 - Wildcard/Judges Choice
- e. Maximum of 3 bids/gym/event

Events with 3 at-large bids

- a. At large #1 - highest overall score at the event
- b. At Large #2 - Highest score in the combined U16/U18/IO eligible divisions
- c. At Large #3 - Highest score in the combined U8/U12 eligible divisions
- d. Maximum of 2 bids/gym/event
